SOLUTIONS

- Because this volume of purchasing activity could not be performed without software automation, the City licensed BuySpeed™ in 2000.
- Since rolling out the BuySpeed™ system in early 2001, Tucson has enabled more than 500 internal customer users and 15,000 vendors on the system.
- The City uses BuySpeed™ for online requisitioning, workflow management, Web-based vendor registration, direct contract ordering, purchase orders and online reporting and inquiry.
- The City will begin online purchase order delivery with BuySpeed™, further reducing the processing time for orders with vendors.
- The City will also begin utilizing Government-to-Business (G2B) linking for system-to-system ordering with various vendors.

CHALLENGES

- The City of Tucson manual purchasing process, based on their financial management system, made requisitioning of contracts, vendor management and workflow management costly and time consuming.
- The City operates a centralized procurement department responsible for processing more than 5,000 annual requisitions and 9,200 purchase orders.
- Last year, 550 separate contracts were awarded by the City that resulted in more than 3,100 direct orders.
