NJSTART – What is it?

NJSTART is The State of New Jersey's online purchasing system for the Division of Purchase & Property (DPP)

- The Division of Purchase & Property (DPP) is within the NJ Department of the Treasury and serves as the State's central procurement agency
 - NJSTART includes all contracts that are a part of the State's Cooperative Purchasing Program
 - DPP's Cooperative Purchasing Program was established by legislation & extends specific State contracts to eligible local buying units
 - **Examples of "local buying units" are:** Municipalities, Counties, School Districts, Volunteer Fire Departments, Volunteer First Aid & Rescue Squads, County & State Colleges, Independent Authorities, Quasi-State Agencies, Independent Institutions of Higher Education



Some of Our State Contract Responsibilities

State Contract T2879 – eProcurement System Transformation – #84203

Amendment #10 added the following responsibilities to Periscope's engagement with the State of New Jersey

Train and support Cooperative Program Participants in how to use NJSTART

Market Cooperative Contracts to Cooperative buyers

Implement a supplier reporting program to enable improved visibility into Cooperative buyer habits and needs

Collect a supplier convenience fee to fund State procurement operations and the support of Cooperative buyers

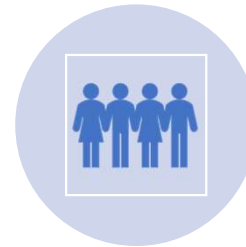

Benefits of Cooperative Purchasing and NJSTART

Cost Effectiveness

- Leverage the State of NJ collective buying power of over \$1bn annually on cooperative contracts.
- Many cooperative programs report an avg. of 19% - 24% savings for participating members.*

Efficiency

- Leverage the NJSTART team to get the data you need for your annual omnibus resolutions.
- Cooperative purchasing reduces the level of effort required to buy.
- As recent as 2017, government procurement offices are understaffed by ~40%.**

Access and What's Available in NJSTART

- 1,000 State of New Jersey Cooperative Contracts across 200 contract portfolios.
- Access national and GSA cooperative contracts approved by SONJ.
- Over 55,000 suppliers for your own sourcing needs.

Compliance

- State contracts are vetted by the State and ready for you to use
 - N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.29 enables local and public-school contracting units to, without advertising for bids, purchase goods or services from designated cooperative contracts through New Jersey DPP.
- Review vendor status for such things as BRC, AAEEOC, MWDSBE Certifications

Why is it important for my organization to register in NJSTART?

- The NJSTART team verifies that the right people are registering your organization.
- Your end-users will be able to access NJSTART, supplier punchouts, and important contract information to become more self-sufficient
- Training available quarterly through online webinars and for individual organizations upon request.
- Your organization will be prepared to better use NJSTART when coming enhancements are available.
- **Don't forget**, whether in NJSTART or not, always enter the State contract number and the State of New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing System Number of "1NJCP" on your PO (NJAC 5:34-7.29).

Reviewing Contracts (Blankets) & Attachments in NJSTART

There are 3 types of Cooperative Contracts available

- T** **State contracts** that are secured through a State Bid Solicitation
- G** **GSA Federal** contracts that are made available
- M** **Cooperative contracts** that are made available through national cooperative purchasing organizations such as NASPO

Typical Attachments Tab Contents

For State Managed Contracts

- Final Bid Solicitation
- Sections 1/2/3or4/5 usually most helpful

For National Cooperatives

- Master Agreement
- Participating Addendum

- MOO Method of Operations
- At-A-Glance
- Award Summary
